Please consider this letter a representation of the County of Del Norte's support for the City of Crescent City's Sunset Circle Multi-Use Trail Project.

The County of Del Norte (County) has worked collaboratively with the City of Crescent City (City) to further progress on the development of the Sunset Circle Multi-Use Trail Project. Our level of support is best demonstrated by the sale of the County's Sunset Circle property to the City for construction of this very project. We have and continue to support the regional prioritization of this project through the Del Norte Local Transportation Commission's planning documents and financial contributions. Active transportation opportunities in the Del Norte County region are minimal and improvements to this facility will reduce active transportation trips along one of the most congested US 101 corridors in the Del Norte region.
