SUBJECT: Second Amendments to Public Defender Agreements for Pelican Bay State Prison Inmates

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve and authorize the Chair to sign the Second Amendments to Agreements with James Fallman, Attorney at Law (Agreement 2013-039), and George Mavris, Attorney at Law (Agreement 2013-038), for Public Defender Services for Pelican Bay State Prison Inmates.

DISCUSSION/JUSTIFICATION:

The cost of providing public defender services to inmates housed at Pelican Bay State Prison is initially a County responsibility that is reimbursed by the State. Claims for reimbursement must be submitted to the State within six months of date of service. The County has contracted with attorneys for these services for almost a decade. This has facilitated timely filing with the state and cost control.

These amendments extend the termination date of the current agreements with Jim Fallman, Attorney at Law and George Mavris, Attorney at Law an additional year to June 30, 2016.

ALTERNATIVES:

Do not extend Agreements and allow the courts to assign cases to non-contracting attorneys.

FINANCING:

Funds for the cost of the Amended Agreements and revenue reimbursement by the State will be contained in the 2015/2016 Fiscal Year Budget.
