SUBJECT: Maintained Mileage Verification for 2016

RECOMMENDATION FOR BOARD ACTION: Approve and adopt the proposed *Resolution Certifying Mileage* for submittal to Caltrans.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION: Each year Caltrans and the Federal Highways Administration request verification of the Public Road Maintained Mileage information for the roadways under County jurisdiction that are maintained and open to the public. The Caltrans Highway Performance Monitoring System Branch certifies county mileage figures to the State Controller, as required for distribution of apportionments to the counties. The certification is submitted in the form of a resolution by the Board of Supervisors and reflects reported mileage maintained for the prior calendar year (i.e. 2016).

As of December 31, 2016, the County had 299.962 miles of maintained public roads. The mileage was lowered by 0.048 miles which reflects the vacation of a segment of Porteck Street in the Pacific Shores Subdivision. The road segment was acquired by the Border Coast Regional Airport Authority as mitigation for the airport terminal replacement project.

**RESOLUTION OF THE DEL NORTE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISOR ESTABLISHING
THT TOTAL MILEAGE OF COUNTY MAINTAINED ROADS AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2015**

WHEREAS, Section 2121 of the California Streets and Highways Code declares that in May of each year, each county shall submit to the California Department of Transportation any additions to, or deletions from its mileage of County Maintained Roads;

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation certified to the State Controller in 2016 that the total mileage of County Maintained Roads in Del Norte County was 300.01 miles as of December 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Del Norte County Community Development Department has recalculated the mileage of the County Maintained Roads in the County of Del Norte using current segment length measurements and the most recent functional classifications; and,

WHEREAS, this resulted in a decrease of 0.048 miles in the total mileage of County Maintained Roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Del Norte County Board of Supervisors hereby establishes the total mileage of County Maintained Roads, as of December 31, 2016, to be 299.962 miles.

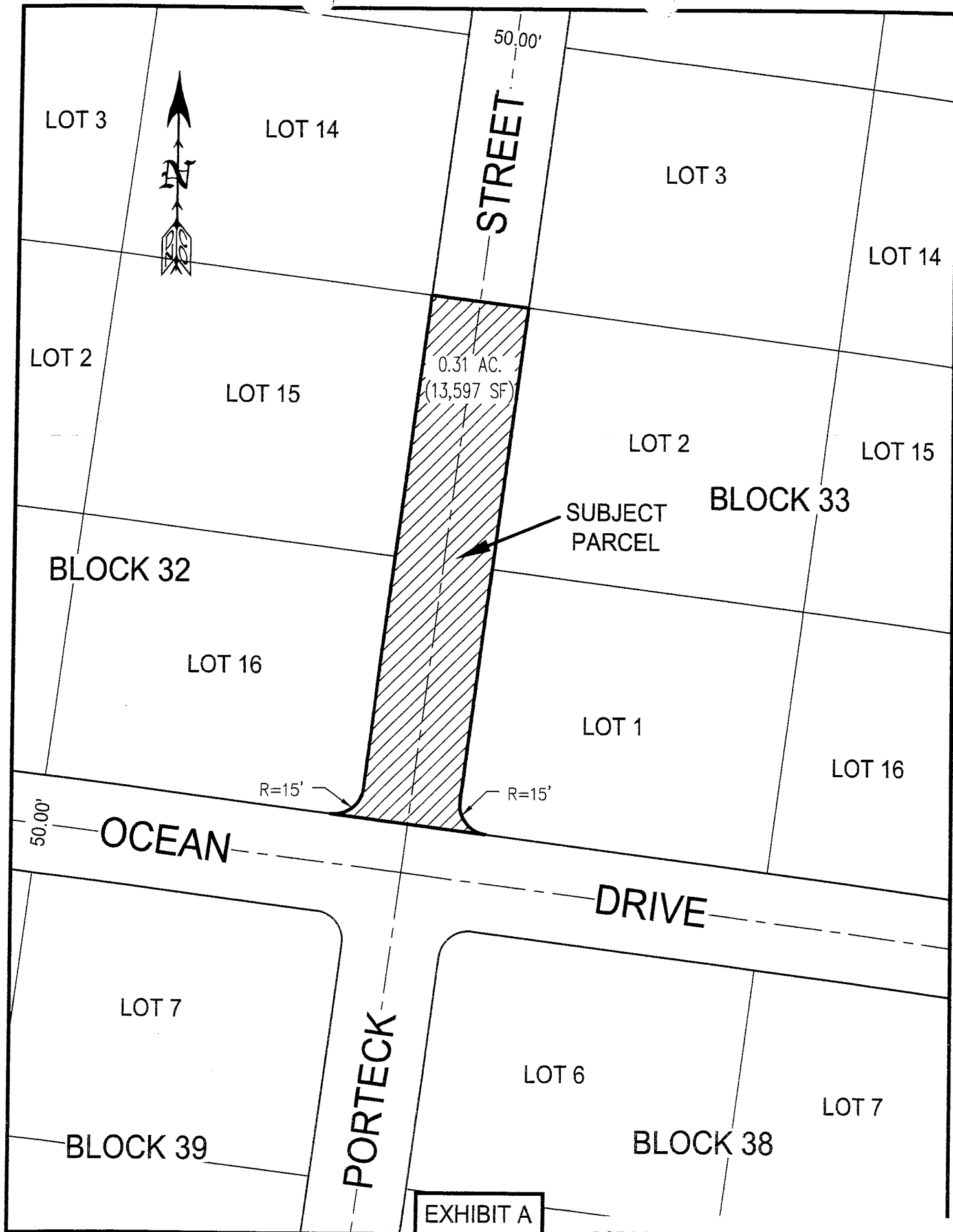

**RESOLUTION OF VACATION
2016-001**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF DEL NORTE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDERING THE VACATION OF A SEGMENT OF PORTECK STREET WITHIN THE PACIFIC SHORES SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, on October 27, 2015 this Board decided to hear the requested vacation and set a public hearing date of November 24, 2015, and a time of 10:45 a.m., for a public hearing before this Board on the issue of said vacation; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that notices of the public hearing were given in accordance with California Streets and Highways Code, Division 9, Part 3, Chapter 3; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that the location of the proposed vacation is not included in the Del Norte County General Plan; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that the location of the proposed vacation is not proposed in regional planning documents to be used as a nonmotorized transportation facility; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that the vacation of said street segment will not eliminate required access to adjoining properties; and

WHEREAS, on November 24, 2015 this Board opened and continued the public hearing to January 12, 2016; and

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2016 this Board conducted the public hearing and thereat heard testimony and considered written evidence as to the need and reasons for vacating this street segment within the Pacific Shores Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that a Notice of Exemption shall be filed since this vacation is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act under Section 15061(b)(3); and

WHEREAS, this Board has found and determined that it is desirable and in the public interest to vacate this street segment within the Pacific Shores Subdivision, as described in Attachment 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNTY OF DEL NORTE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- A. This Board finds, based on all the heard testimony and written evidence submitted, that the street segment within the Pacific Shores Subdivision, as described in Attachment 1, is unnecessary for present or prospective use, and is hereby vacated subject to the following conditions:
 - 1. Prior to recording the Resolution of Vacation, the applicant shall provide the Engineering Division with a map showing all past and present street segments

approved by the Board of Supervisors for vacation within the Pacific Shores Subdivision. A note shall be placed on the map stating: "All street segments proposed for vacation and associated with Resolution of Vacation 2014-058 have been vacated.";

2. Prior to the recordation of the Resolution of Vacation, the applicant shall prepare a deed, acceptable to the County Surveyor, to transfer ownership of the vacated street segment from the County of Del Norte to the Border Coast Regional Airport Authority;
 3. No street segments shall be vacated that create landlocked parcels;
 4. Prior to the recordation of the Resolution of Vacation, all parcels shall have at least ten feet of frontage along adjoining streets;
 5. Prior to the recordation of the Resolution of Vacation, the applicant shall pay the Road Fund \$3,000/acre for the acquisition of street segments within the Pacific Shores Subdivision;
 6. At the time of the recordation of the Resolution of Vacation, the applicant shall provide the Engineering Division with a map showing the street segments that will be vacated. The area of actual vacation may be less than what was approved, if it is necessary, to meet the condition of approval;
 7. Any road base material removed from the vacated street segments within 5 years of the recordation of the Resolution of Vacation shall be offered, free of charge, to the County of Del Norte for the maintenance of existing roads within the Pacific Shores Subdivision. Hauling and placement of road base material will be the responsibility of the County; and
 8. After recordation of the Resolution of Vacation and prior to the completion of the wetland mitigation component of the Runway Safety Area Project, a barrier system, acceptable to the County Engineer and Road Superintendent, shall be installed at the ends of all vacated roadway segments; and
 9. This Resolution of Vacation shall be null and void if recorded after June 30, 2016.
- B. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to record this order declaring vacation of the subject street(s) described in Attachment 1 in the Office of the Del Norte County Recorder only after conditions required by the Board of Supervisors have been satisfied.




